



Early Years Additional Information

- All clothing should be clearly named, especially shoes, socks and coats
- For Outdoor Learning all students must wear appropriate clothing for the time of year e.g. leggings, long sleeved top/t-shirt/jumper/warm waterproof coat. Clothing must allow for the girls to be independent as much as possible.
- A complete change of clothes must be left in their gym bags at all times.
- All students to wear black/blue school shoes as per the school uniform guide.
- If your son or daughter has long hair it needs to be tied up and away from their face with blue slides or hair band. This is in line with School Policy.
- All students to have a named blue lunch apron.
- Wellington boots – appropriate time of year.
- Morning snack –Please provide your son or daughter with a mid-morning snack consisting of one piece of fruit or vegetables.
- Lunch starts at 12pm. School lunches are cooked on site by the school caterers. A weekly menu can be found on the school website. We ask that your son/ daughter does not bring in sweets, chocolate or fizzy drinks. Pick-up after lunch is 12.40pm.
- Early Years opens at 8am and drop off is directly into the Early Years classrooms. The gate into Early Years is situated at the far end of the main car park. Members of staff will be on hand to receive your son /daughter. For Pre-Nursery and Nursery our morning session is 8.45 -11.45. The afternoon session is 12.00 - 3.15 (including lunch).
- If your son/ daughter is being collected by someone other than you please inform a member of Early Years team
- If you would like to speak to the Early Years team about your son/ daughter, please feel free to telephone the school office and arrange an appointment.
- Gym kit – Please leave your son's/daughter's gym kit in school at all times. Inside their gym bag they should have a tracksuit, white trainers, socks, white aertex top/t-shirt, blue shorts and a spare pair of knickers, socks/tights.
- Please can you inform us of any change of emergency or contact telephone numbers as soon as possible.
- A detailed timetable of activities and experiences will be issued once your son/ daughter starts.
